Thus, several activities were carried out by students in different localities under the supervision of AFROHUN representatives and on various aspects of the problem of One Health.

The following poster is entitled "Summary of SOHIC's activities during 2002"

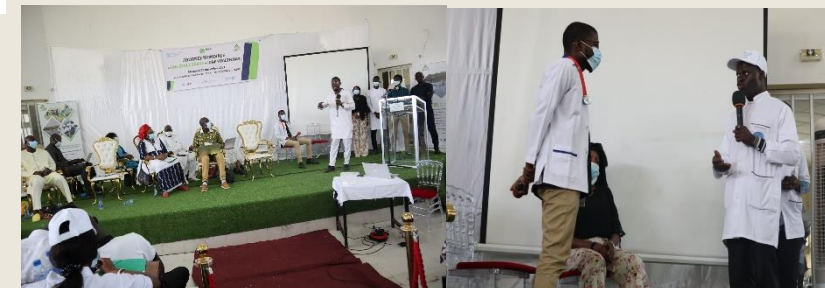
Training on nutrition

- Training of community relays on malnutrition
- Women's formation on children's nutrition aged from 0 to 5 years
- Women's formation on alimentary hygiene



University sensitization

The SOHIC has trained 5 relays and more than 100 women on children's nutrition and food hygiene. teachers of the elementary communal school participated at the training and they have been designed for the monitoring.

Formation on climate change resilience

- Sensitization on climate change resilience



The SOHIC, in collaboration with the prefecture of Mbirkelane's department has sensitized all the departmental services on One Health approach. total of 19 departmental services, 3 communal relays, 3 presidents of women groupments and the director of the local radio have been trained.

The sohic, in collaboration with the Senegalese institute of Agricole Research (ISRA), the national agricole and rural counselor agency, the departmental service for water and Forests; has trained the teaching staff and the students of 2 elementary schools, 1 highschool and 9 presidents of women associations about the good practices related to climate change resilience

Community awareness

- Sensitization on rabies in KAFFRINE
- Discussion between students and populations about rabies



The sohic, has led a wide sensitization on rabies in neighbourhoods and the 3 big markets of Mbirkelane departments (Kaffrine). Hundreds of persons has been sensitized on rabies. We had started the sensitisation with radio messages diffused on the local radio for 1 week.



Conclusion

One Health is expanding both institutionally and educationally and SOHIC hopes through various activities to become the cornerstone of collective and executive awareness in this area. However, limitations are often noted especially in terms of the implementation and understanding of the concept and its integration into services.
